



Here's What's New at Kaleideum!

Kaleideum kicked off the fall with new hours, admission rates, and birthday party packages, in addition to the exciting programs and events featured in this newsletter.

"As part of our effort to make Kaleideum a regular part of our community's life, we have streamlined our admission pricing and hours

across both locations," said Elizabeth Dampier, Executive Director. "We are also offering extended hours one day each month so that working families can take part in an evening adventure at either location."

During the school year, both Kaleideum locations are open 9 am-4 pm, Tuesday-Friday;

10 am-5 pm on Saturday; and 1-5 pm on Sunday. **On the third Thursday of every month, both locations will be open until 8 pm.** Kaleideum Downtown is closed the first Monday of each month; it is open on other Mondays from 9 am-Noon for members. Kaleideum North is closed on Mondays.

Admission prices at both locations are \$9 for adults and youth ages 1-19. Seniors are \$8, and ages 11 months and under are free. Military personnel receive a \$1 discount.

Membership prices have remained the same. A Family Membership (\$135) includes both museums, discounts on birthday parties and camps, discounted admission with museums affiliated with ASTC and ACM, plus many other benefits! If a family of four visits Kaleideum four times in one year, then the membership has paid for itself!

Kaleideum also has a new birthday party program, with three types of birthday parties: Birthday Bash, Kaleideum Super Party, and Custom Birthday Celebration. For more information and pricing, visit kaleideum.org!
