Day-of registration available at the door if space is available—\$7/class for member-child (1 free adult), \$9/class for nonmember-child (1 free adult, Museum admission included.)

Sensory Friendly Monday—Children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and sensory processing differences are invited to have a fun, enjoyable, and interactive learning experience in a comfortable and accepting environment! Sensory Friendly Mondays are offered one day per month, September – May, on Members Only Mondays (9 am - 12 pm) when attendance is light. You do not need to be a member in order to attend, but admission or membership is required. Our Sensory Friendly modifications include choice boards and a designated quiet room.
