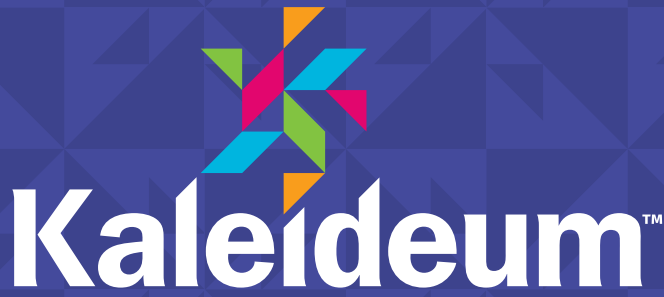

Is Your Middle Schooler Interested in a Healthcare Profession?



Explore medicine from
Rescue to Recovery
at Kaleideum North this summer!

Kaleideum has partnered with Wake Forest School of Medicine and Northwest AHEC on a special healthcare-focused camp for rising 7th-8th graders this summer. For children interested in the medical doctor or EMT profession, this camp provides role-playing scenarios that focus on potentially life-threatening situations. Campers will learn basic first aid and the steps to take until help arrives. In addition, they will participate in hands-on experiences in an ambulance, tour a medical facility, and meet the healthcare professionals who go from “rescue to recovery” every single day.

Choose from one of two weeks (camps are identical):
July 24-28 or **July 31-August 4**

Rescue to Recovery camp runs from 9 am to 5 pm. Need-based scholarships are available. If you are interested in applying for a scholarship, please contact Kelli Isenhour at (336) 714-7106 to request an application form.

Explore the Design-Build-Test cycle through hands-on experiments. Discover DaVinci's interlocking bridge, experiment with the Marble Run Station, build with Giant Blue Blocks, and more!

What does it take to create a video game, line up rhythms like the best DJs, or design a roller coaster that produces the biggest thrills? In *DESIGN ZONE*, go behind the scenes and see how creative problem solvers use math to do amazing things. *DESIGN ZONE* explores mathematical concepts like patterns, variables, scale, slope, and ratios used by artists, architects, engineers, musicians, and other innovators.

Take an overseas adventure without leaving your hometown when Kaleideum Downtown hosts *Children's China: Celebrating Culture, Character and Confucius*. This interactive exhibit, designed for children 3 to 12 years, explores what life is like for children in China today through six different immersive environments.

Children's China is part of the Freeman Foundation Asian Culture Exhibit Series, funded by The Freeman Foundation and administered by the Association of Children's Museums. Created by The Magic House in partnership with the Confucius Institute at Webster University and Character Plus, *Children's China* is a nationally traveling exhibit designed to increase understanding of the Chinese culture.
