Dear Camp Grown-up,

Drop-off begins at 8:45 am. Early-care (available for FULL DAY campers) begins at 8 am and costs \$5/day. Kaleideum North is located at 400 West Hanes Mill Road. We thank you for your patience and understanding as drop off and pick up will require additional time this summer.

The sign-in table will be located outside the front doors of Kaleideum North. Please walk your camper to the table and practice physical distancing should you need to wait. A staff member will take your child's temperature and ask a series of health questions. *If your child's temperature is over 100.4 (per CDC recommendation) or they or someone in your household are showing signs of illness, they will not be permitted to attend camp.* A child can return to camp if they are symptom-free *without medication* after 72 hours, have a doctor's note, or a negative COVID-19 test result. A staff member will walk your child to their classroom. Caregivers are asked to not enter the building. Once the governor allows indoor entertainment venues like museums to operate, Kaleideum North will open to the public at 10 am. Mondays are for Members-only. Kaleideum will monitor and enforce state guidelines regarding the maximum number of people permitted to be in the Museum.

In the event of rain in the morning, drop-off will be conducted outside in a car-line style. You will be waived to the sign-in table under the tent when it's your turn.

Pick-up will take place by the door to FoodWorks. Signs will be placed outside to direct you. The registration table will be located outside unless there is inclement weather, in which case the table will be located inside the building. Please practice physical distancing should you need to wait. To ensure your child's safety, anyone picking up your child must be listed on their Camper Registration Sheet (the questions answered when camp was purchased) or Special Instruction Form (available at the sign-in table). **Adults will be asked to show a photo ID upon pick-up.** A staff member will walk your child to you.

Pick-up for Half Day campers will take at place at **12:30 pm**.

Pick-up for Full Day campers will take at place at **4:00 pm**. After-care is available until 5:30 pm and costs \$5/day.

**Masks:**

- Campers will NOT be required to wear masks but can do so if they wish.
- Staff will wear masks except when eating and drinking or engaging in outdoor activities unless they are not able to maintain a safe physical distance from campers.
- Museum guests are recommended to wear masks.

### **Safety & Sanitation Protocols**

- Our top priority is the safety and well-being of our campers, guests, staff, and animals. Long before Coronavirus appeared, Kaleideum prioritized keeping the Museums clean and disinfected. We will continue to meet the highest standards of our cleaning protocol, which includes disinfecting our facilities, exhibits, and exhibit props daily with an EPA approved, hospital-grade disinfectant proven to kill COVID-19.
- Kaleideum staff follow basic hygiene practices, such as frequent handwashing and using alcohol-based sanitizers.
- Kaleideum staff received training on COVID-19 response through the Workforce Restart program.
- Campers will learn and practice proper hand washing techniques. There is a sink in each classroom.
- Kaleideum staff will have their temperature taken and will answer a series of health questions before they are permitted to begin their shift.

### **During the Day:**

- Campers will play in the Museum before 10 am and during non-peak hours.
- Campers will stay in their small groups of 16-20.
- Full day campers will have their temperatures re-checked between 12:30-1:30 pm. *If your child's temperature is over 100.4, they will be masked and isolated, and you will be contacted to pick them up from camp. We will ask you to pull up to the front of the building and call the staff member who is with your child. We will walk out to your vehicle. Please do not enter the building.*
